



The competition is stroke play, two best scores to count 100% handicap allowance, maximum handicaps Men 28, Ladies 36 (Ladies will also receive 3 extra shots added to their handicap)

FIRST AMATEUR IS RESPONSIBLE

- For recording the professionals gross score
- Having the measuring tape and ensuring it is used accurately

TEAM PROFESSIONAL IS RESPONSIBLE

- For his team's card, entering the two best nett scores from the 4 team members per hole.
- Ensuring that his team's handicaps are correct
- Ensuring the rules and spirit of golf are followed.

LADY MEMBERS OF BOLDMERE GOLF CLUB

• Ladies to use the Men's stroke indexes as per the score card, and will receive 3 extra shots to their handicap.





BOLDMERE GOLF CLUB

Boldmere Golf Club was established in 1936 originally as a 9 hole golf course. A score of 56 by R.Bardesley from Moor Hall Golf Club, in 2010, stands as the lowest round at Boldmere Golf Club. The record was previously held for 20 years by P.Weaver, scoring 57. Achieving a 7 under par round at Boldmere, with all of its challenging par 3's, is no mean feat
